












Letter formation	Sound	Action	Story
	ch as in chips, chop, church and much  (Not words where the 'ch' is making a different sound e.g. chrome or choir)	Pretend you are shaking maracas dancing a cha cha.	The caterpillar and the horse had a party.
	sh as in shop, show, shed and fish	Put your finger to your lips.	The snake and the horse are creeping quietly.
	th as in this, think, with and weather	Put your thumb up.	The tower gave a thumbs up to the horse.
	ng as in song, ring, finger, bang	Point to your ring finger.	Nobby and the girl got married. He gave her a ring.
	ai as in rain, tail, pain, snail, train  (Not words where the 'ai' is part of 'air' e.g. chair or hair)	Move fingers down like rain.	The apple was eaten by the insect in the rain.
	ee as in cheese, see, feel, green  (Not words where the 'ee' is part of 'eer' e.g. deer or cheer)	Smile and like you would when saying cheese for the camera.	Two eggs say cheeeese! (smiling for a picture)
	igh as in high, light, night and bright	Pretend to switch on the light	The insect, the girl and the horse put on the light.

	oa as in coat, boat, moan and road	Pretend to put your coat on.	The orange and the apple were in my coat pocket.
	oo as in look, book, moon, and spoon (Note, sometimes the oo is a short sound as in book and sometimes it is long sound as in soon)	Put your hands up to your eyes curled like binocul-ars.	Oooooo!! Look at that! (Pretend to use binoculars)
	ar as in car, farm, dark and part	Pretend to drive a car.	The apple was eaten by a robot driving a car.
	or as in fork, sport, corn and torch	Pretend to use a fork	The orange was eaten by a robot with a fork.
	ur as in fur, nurse, curl and hurt  (Not words where the 'ur' is part of 'ure' e.g. pure or endure)	Pretend to stroke and animal's fur	The umbrella robot stroked the cat's soft fur.
	ow as in cow, town, down and shower  (Not words where the 'ow' is making a different sound e.g. show or below)	Hold your arm as if it hurts	The orange was bitten by the worm, ow!
	oi as in join, boil, avoid and oil	Pretend to join two things together.	The orange blocks were joined by the insect.

	<p>ear as in dear, fear, clear and near</p> <p>(Not words where the 'ear' is making a different sound e.g. learn, earth, heart or wear)</p>	Point to your ear.	The egg, apple and robot all had big ears!
	air as in chair, hair, fairy and funfair	Point to/show your hair	The apple, the insect and the robot all had funny hair!
	ure as in pure, cure, endure and lure	Pretend to lure something towards you.	The umbrella robot lured the egg into the frying pan!
	er as in her, germ, shower and bigger	Use your hand to pretend it is a shower over your head.	The egg fell on the robot so it needed a shower.
