#### **Contact Tracing over the Holidays**

During the school holidays SLT members have been asked to be on call to assist with contact tracing. If your child develops symptoms of COVID19 within 48 hours after their last day at West Green Primary School (for the vast majority of students the 48 hours will end at 12:30pm on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April) you must seek a test for your child and the household must isolate at home until the test result is returned.

After booking a test you must contact the school and let us know/keep us up to date on the outcome of the test.

#### **Covid Testing**

Haringey has 3 rapid COVID-19 test sites for people who are not showing any signs of having the virus. The centres are at the following locations:

- 48 Station Road, Wood Green, N22 7TY
- Tottenham Community Sports Centre, 701-703 High Road, Tottenham, N17 8AD
- The Transmitter Tower, Alexandra Palace, Alexandra Palace Way, N22 7AY

The days and hours of operation are as follows:

- onday: 8am to 4pm
- Tuesday/Wednesday: 8am to 8pm
- Thursday/Friday/Saturday: 8am to 4pm
- Sunday: 10am to 2pm

If you cannot attend a testing site You can order kits to test your household, childcare bubble or support bubble if at least one member:

- is a school pupil
- works in a school (this includes temporary workers or volunteers)

There are different ways to access the home testing kits. One way is to collect the home testing kits from a PCR testing site in the borough. Those who are not able to collect home testing kits can place an order for them to be delivered to their home address. Those eligible to receive home testing kits can follow this link <a href="https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests">https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests</a> which provides information on collection points and also gives the option of ordering the tests to be posted. Please note that anyone collecting a home testing kit, can collect up to two kits. Each home testing kit contains 7 tests.



### Trailblazer (Mental Health Support Team)





Dear Parents and Carers,

We wanted to remind you of what our service is currently offering in West Green Primary. The Trailblazer Project is a nationwide initiative with joint working between Department of Education and Department of Health. The project aims to provide early intervention programmes in schools to improve children's and young people's emotional wellbeing.

## Who are we?

The Haringey Trailblazer team is made up of a range of different therapists and practitioners. We are trained to work with children aged 4-18 years, as well as with parents of primary school-aged children, on a range of mental health and well-being topics.

#### What we do?

## Working with parents to support their children

Working with parents is the most effective intervention for primary aged children. We offer 1:1 parent programmes and guidance for 6-8 sessions covering:



- Anxiety management (e.g. fears/phobias, feeling panicky and worries about family or friends) for children aged 5-11
- <u>Behavioural management</u> (e.g. difficulties following rules and requests, temper tantrums) for children aged 4-8



We use an approach called guided self-help to provide you with tools and materials to help with your difficulties. We like to start by meeting you to get a better understanding of your current problems and to hear about what's going well and what you would like support with.

#### Working with children

Brain Buddies is an 8 week group-based programme which aims to develop students' understanding of their emotions. We do this by helping them to develop strategies for identifying and regulating their emotions through self-care strategies, problem-solving and communication.
