

Blue Class Overview

Spring Term 2023

Here is an overview of the curriculum covered in the Spring term. This can be used as guidance to help support your child's learning at school and home.

English

This term we will be reading fictional books, including Storm by Kevin Crossley-Holland, we will also be reading a Roman playscript and several poems by poets including Maya Angelou and Roger McGough. We will also explore literature based on our History and Geography units. Our Year 4s will write for effect, making conscience choices that engage their reader. They will use a variety of techniques such as expanded noun phrases, literary features and structure to create and sustain interest.

Maths

In Year 4 we will be covering:

Fractions

Time

Decimals

Area and perimeter
Multiplication facts:
Building and developing
the multiplication tables
all the way up to 12x and
preparing for the times
tables test (taking place
during the summer term).

Reading

At West Green we use an Accelerated Reader Programme to support and inspire our children to read. Reading is important and we expect that children will read every night at home. After finishing a book children will complete a quiz which shows that they really understood what they have read. The quiz pass mark is 85% and children who achieve 100% will become part of our 100% club!

Children can now quiz at home.

History, Geography & Science

Science: During Spring term we will be learning all about the topics: the science of sound and living things and their habitats. These lessons will be accompanied by experiments and investigations to support the children's learning and development.

Geography: During Spring term we will be learning all about the topics: coastal processes and tourism.

History: During Spring term we will be learning all about the topics: Roman Britain and Christianity and the three empires.

Important Dates

In year 1 our PE is on **Mondays**. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on this day.

Art is on Wednesdays.

Music is on **Thursdays** and Mandarin is on **Fridays**.

Year 4 Learning Expectations
